# Alt Vox Season 6

Alt Vox is pleased to announce that on Tuesday, September 13, 2022, we will return to in-person singing for our 6<sup>th</sup> season!

The season will run from September 13, 2022 (first rehearsal) to June 10, 2023 (end-of-season concert).

### **Rehearsal details:**

Rehearsals are on Tuesdays from 7-9 pm and will take place in the Bloor & Sherbourne area.

There will be a **10-minute break** halfway through rehearsal.

Sheet music will be sent via email prior to each rehearsal to print/download. Alt Vox will not be providing printed sheet music at rehearsal.

Rehearsals will be video-recorded and uploaded later the same evening. Rehearsal will no longer be live streamed via Zoom.

We may sing with masks on for a portion of the season. Singers' masks will be available for purchase at rehearsal for \$2.

#### Song Choices for Season 6:

As usual, there is a LOOOOONG list of songs to choose from, so here is a short list of artists Alt Vox plans to cover this season:

Alt Vox will also revisit some material from Seasons 3 & 4 that we have yet to perform in concert:

The song list will evolve over the course of the season, so we may not get to all of these artists.

Additionally, we may pull songs from previous seasons that Alt Vox HAS performed previously.

There are also a few artists we will cover that are not listed here.

## Alt Vox in Public:

While Alt Vox will continue to be a rehearsal-based choir, there will still be public performance opportunities:

- The return of **Pub Nights**:
  - Every couple of months, we'll hold rehearsal in a local pub and sing along with a live band while having a few drinks!
  - This will happen 3-4 times throughout the season.
- We also plan to create another **choir video**. The audio and video will be recorded over the course of the season.
- There will be one **major concert** at the end of the season (June 10, 2023).
- There **may** be one small "Friends & Family Concert/Open Rehearsal" mid-way through the season.

The End-of-Season concert will be in-person (450-person venue) AND live-streamed for out-of-town friends & family. It will be a licenced event. Ticket prices will be ~\$30 (plus applicable fees/HST).

Other social events will pop up throughout the season. (Karaoke, bowling, BBQs, etc.)

As with everything Alt Vox, participation in any of these activities is encouraged but not mandatory.

### Pricing:

Due to the rising cost of, well, EVERYTHING, Alt Vox needs to increase prices as well. (All prices include HST.)

- The full season's fees are now **\$400**.
- The Student/Recent graduate rate is now **\$250**.
- The 6-consecutive-week package is now **\$95**.

All fees are cumulative; You will never pay more than the full season's fees.

There is also the **sponsorship program**, in which a limited number of applicants may be admitted at no cost on a case-by-case basis.

### New Members:

Members who joined in Season 5, as well as anyone who has yet to sing with Alt Vox will be asked to do a quick vocal assessment with Donavon prior to their first rehearsal in Season 6 to make sure they're placed in the correct section.

Alt Vox was created for the enjoyment of choral singing.

As a rehearsal-based choir, we get together every week to sing through great songs in a low-stress, highfun environment with a highly entertaining (and hilariously profane) director!
